Details:

This unique penthouse apartment is situated in Palma on the edge of the former fisherman's quarter of Santa Catalina, around the centuries-old market hall. The trendy district is characterised by its tree-lined streets with colourful little houses and art nouveau villas. Numerous designer boutiques and second-hand shops can be found here, next to cocktail lounges, music cafés and rustic, authentic pubs.

Distributed over its constructed living area of 110 sqm are 2 bedrooms, 2 bathrooms, one of which is en suite, an inviting living room, and a bright openly-designed kitchen and dining area. It would also be possible to integrate a third complete bedroom if desired.

A highlight of the property is the 72 sqm private terrace with integrated outdoor kitchen, shower, and ample space for convivial get-togethers with friends and family. From here there are views over the hilly landscape surrounding Palma, the Castell Bellver fortress, the sea, and Mallorca's famous landmark, the cathedral. There is also a 2nd, smaller terrace of 8 sqm which also provides views over the rooftops of Santa Catalina.

Numerous large window frontages allow the entry of ample natural light, and the original tiled flooring bestows great charm and authenticity upon the apartment.

Further features include hot/cold air conditioning, gas central heating, double-glazed windows, and a lift. An optional garage space can also be rented if required.
