

#### **Details:**

This unique property is situated in the picturesque and desirable district of 'Es Jonquet', on the water close to Santa Catalina, and in an elevated location above the Royal Yacht Club in the centre of the harbour. It is only 2 minutes away from shops and restaurants.

The property, one of the oldest and largest in the whole area, has a living space of 376 sqm spread over 3 levels, with an exterior area of 118 sqm.

Housed on the ground floor is the entrance hall, 3 bedrooms, 2 bathrooms, a 2-car garage, and a 30 sqm inner patio with access to a terrace.

On the first floor is a large living/dining area with adjoining open kitchen with a wonderful terrace of 88 sqm with jacuzzi. Relaxing here in absolute privacy the spectacular views of the cathedral and the harbour of Palma can be enjoyed.

The upper floor consists of the main bedroom with designer-bathroom en suite, and a 2nd bedroom which is currently used as an office.

Further features of this grand property include underfloor heating, hot/cold air conditioning, and micro-cement floors.
